

Airedale Terrier

If this dog is being shown, he would have to be hand stripped, but if he is your pet you can maintain this coat with clippers.

Ears need to be clipped with the blade at its shortest setting. Ears can cut easily so keep fingers under the edges at all times. Do the insides too.

For the face and top of the head you will want to use the clipper on the longest setting and without a guide comb.

Use a #1 guide comb for the throat and chest area.

You will want to make the body short with the legs a little longer. Use a #2 guide comb for blending the body into the legs, but be careful not to cut into the leg hair.

If the dog has a lot of leg furnishings, you can use a #4 guide comb over the legs to take off some of the length.
