

Border Terrier



This little terrier has a harsh, wiry coat. To keep him looking like the sleek-bodied dog he is, you can use a #2 guide comb or a #1 for a shorter, summer cut. Use the guide comb over the entire dog including legs and tail.

Their faces should look a bit like an otter, so don't leave the beard or eyebrows too long. You can clip over the top of the head and cheeks with a #1 guide comb. For the muzzle, you can use either a #3 guide comb or trim with scissors.

When clipping the ears go very slowly and keep your fingers under the edges at all times to prevent cutting the edge.
