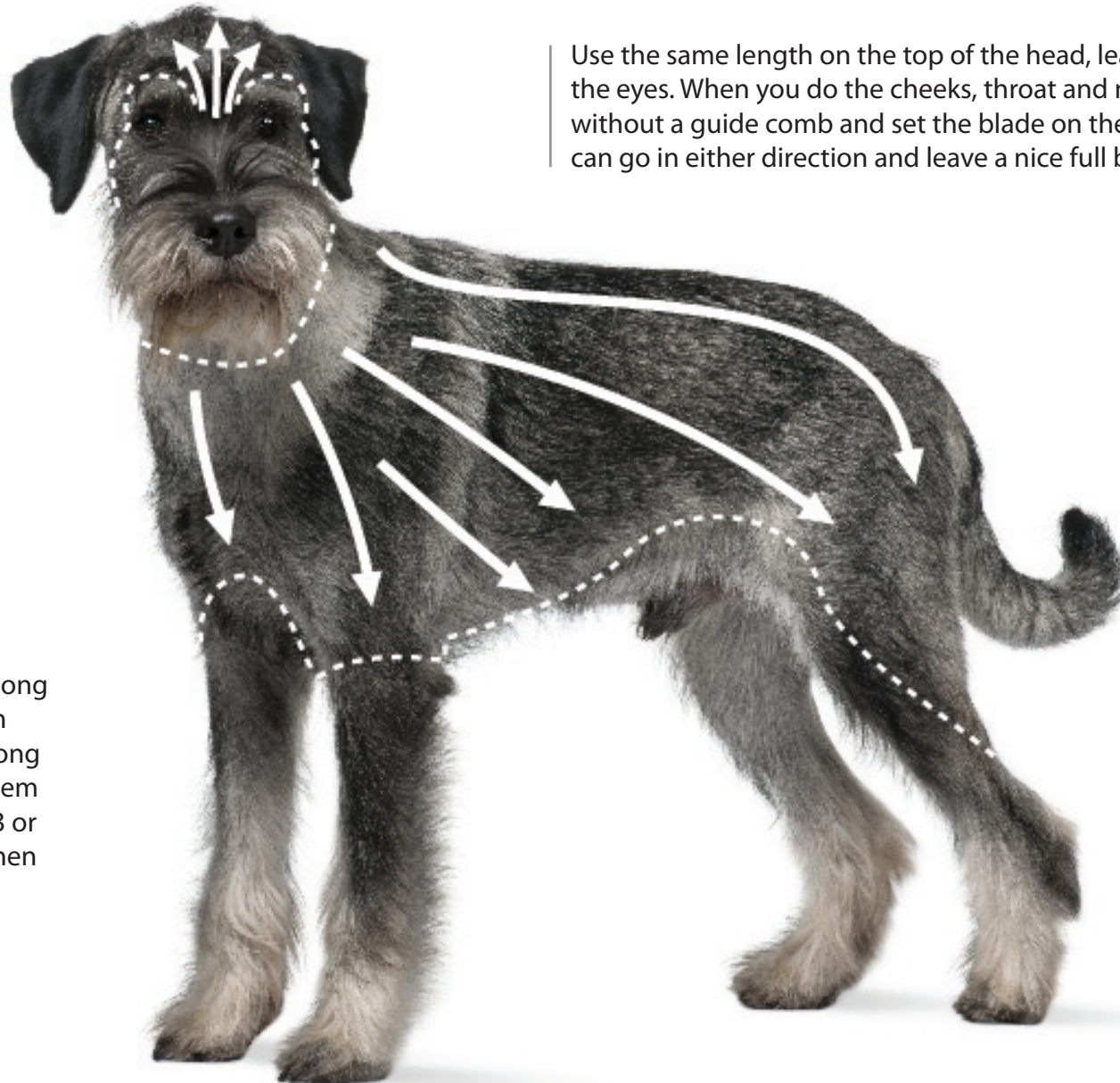


Standard Schnauzer

This is the middle schnauzer and he generally has a longer coat than the Giant Schnauzer, but shorter than the miniature size. Use a #2 or #1 guide comb to do the body. Do not cut too short because this can allow the skin to become overexposed to the sun.



Use the same length on the top of the head, leaving eyebrows over the eyes. When you do the cheeks, throat and neck use the clipper without a guide comb and set the blade on the longest setting. You can go in either direction and leave a nice full beard and mustache.

If the leg hair is not too long you can finish them with scissors. If they are too long and you would prefer them shorter, you can use a #3 or #4 down the legs and then finish with the scissors.

Trim feet with scissors.
