

Fox Terrier (Wire)

Shave ears with blade set on the shortest setting. Keep fingers under ears at all times so you don't cut the edges of the ear.

Use the same #2 or #1 guide comb on the top of the head as you used on the body. Sides of face and throat should be shaved with the clipper without a guide comb. Set the blade on the longest setting and go with the grain of the fur.

He has a very harsh coat and because he is a terrier, can be a handful to groom. You want his head/face to be squared off, almost brick-like in shape.

Use a #2 or #1 guide comb all over his body, leaving his legs and lower chest area fuller. He should not have a skirt, but a nice underline on the bottom part of the ribs. If you find that his leg hair is too long, you can shorten it by either using scissors or a #3 or #4 guide comb and then finish the legs with scissors.
