

# Gordon Setter

It is a lot of work to trim these dogs. They are a high energy breed and can be antsy on the table.

Clip the body with a #2 guide comb, blending into the dotted areas. Come down the front legs, leaving the furnishings on the back part of the front legs. On the rear legs come down in a V-like pattern, leaving furnishings on the front and rear sides of the back leg.

The head, face, cheeks and throat can be shaved using the clipper without a guide comb. Set the blade on a longer setting and go with the grain of the fur. Trim the top  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the ear leaving the front edge and fringe on the lower part of the ear.

Trim feet with scissors. Brush the hair up on the feet and then cut.
