

Irish Terrier

This terrier should look smooth and sleek. Use a #1 or #2 guide comb for the top of the head and entire body. Leave light leg furnishings. If your dog grows more furnishings than shown, you can either use the same comb on the legs that was used for the body or one number longer if you would like a little more length.



Do the top of the head with the same blade you used for the body, leaving a small eyebrow over eyes. Use clipper without guide comb to do sides of face, throat and neck areas, leaving a mustache and beard.

Trim feet nice and tight with scissors.
