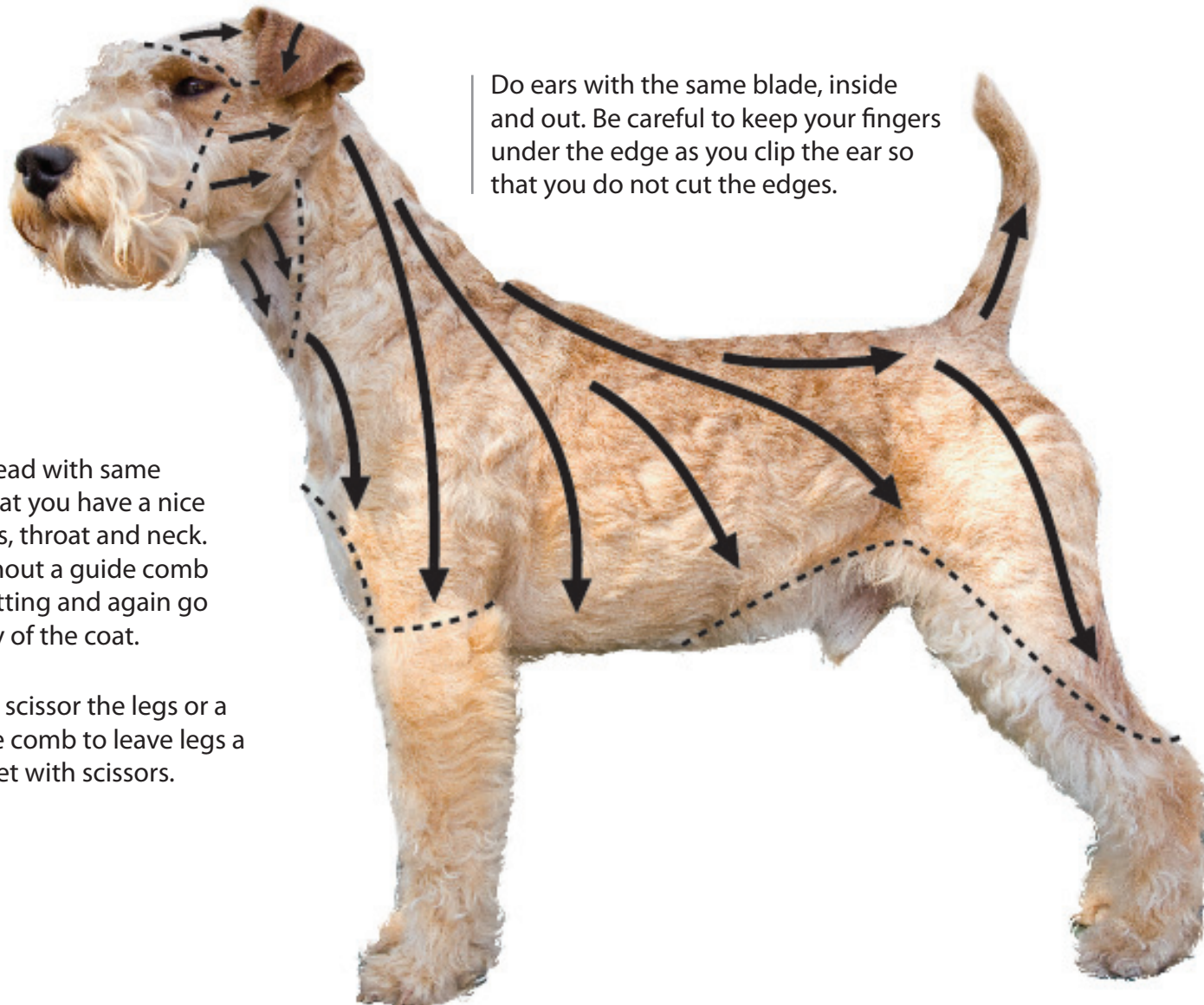


Lakeland Terrier

This little dog has a very wiry, harsh coat. It also has a slight wave to it. If this dog were going to be shown it would have to be hand stripped which takes a long time to do, but needs to be done every week or two. If you don't intend to show it, you can use a clipper to get this look. I would recommend using a #2 or if you want a little shorter a #1 guide comb. Go in the direction of the lay of the coat, do not go in reverse.



Do ears with the same blade, inside and out. Be careful to keep your fingers under the edge as you clip the ear so that you do not cut the edges.

Do the top of the head with same comb as body so that you have a nice blend on the cheeks, throat and neck. Use the clipper without a guide comb set to the lowest setting and again go with the grain or lay of the coat.

If you want you can scissor the legs or a use a #4 or #5 guide comb to leave legs a little longer. Trim feet with scissors.
