

Lhasa Apso

This little dog can be difficult to care for with a full coat. Typically, the only ones in full coats are show dogs. To keep in coat as shown in the picture requires daily brushings and combings as well as baths every 2 weeks. It is recommend that this dog be kept in a puppy cut. Puppy cuts can vary in lengths, depending on how often you want to brush and groom your dog.

To achieve a puppy cut a good guide comb would be a #3 or #4. That way they have a little fluff without taking too much time brushing. It is recommended to groom this breed every 4 to 6 weeks.

Often the head and face are done with the same guide comb or one comb longer. This keeps the hair out of their eyes and can help with the tearing they sometimes have.
