

Poodle

To get this length on your poodle's body, use a #3 or #4 guide comb. You can adjust the length of your poodle as desired; using a higher number for longer or lower numbers for shorter.

You can trim the head and around the feet with scissors. If your poodle's head has gotten too long you can use your longest guide comb to go over the head and then scissor to finish.

Be careful when clipping the head without a guide comb. Stay level from the eye to the ear.

Clip the face in reverse with the clipper blade set to the longest setting. Come up the throat to the end of jaw. Come from the outside of the ear to the corner of the eye. Come down from the eye to the nose. Stretching the skin taut will make it easier to clip the face.

Clip the feet, going in reverse with the clipper set at the shortest setting on the blade. Go up to the little bone that protrudes on the side of the feet. Spread toes apart to get in between. Be careful not to cut the webbing between the toes.

Clip the base of the tail about 2" with the same blade setting you used on the face. Do under the tail too, clipping on either side of the rectum.
