

# Scottish Terrier

Of all the terriers, this one is probably the toughest one. Very often, they don't like their grooming, especially when it comes to brushing the front legs and cutting nails. So introduce your Scotty early to having this done. Their coats are very wiry; you can clipper the body with a #2 or #1 guide comb. Most people leave their Scotty's body pretty short, leaving their skirt and legs long and natural.

Do top of head with the same blade as you do cheeks, neck and throat area. Use the clipper without a guide comb, with the setting on the lowest setting. Go from the outside corner of the eye back toward the ears, leaving a full beard and muzzle. Clip the ears as well, keeping fingers under the edges so that you do not cut the edge.
