# Soft-Coated Wheaton Terrier

If you wanted to keep your Wheaton Terrier in a coat like this, it will require a lot of brushing and combing. This coat is very soft and mats easily. Most "Wheaties" are groomed in a puppy cut which is much easier to keep up with.

For the trim pictured, the body is done with a #5 or #6 guide comb, with the legs scissored or using a #7 and finishing with a scissors. For less grooming, you can clip him down to a #4 or #5 all over including the legs and then do the head with one blade longer and finish trimming with scissors.

This breed generally has a full "fall" over the eyes and a full beard and mustache as shown in the picture. However, frequently people who own a "Wheatie" and do not show them opt for a much shorter face and to clip off the fall so that the hair is not in their way.
