

Tibetan Terrier

This breed has a very long and flowing coat. To keep it in this condition, you will need to brush and comb daily. If brushed regularly, he will stay mat free. Very often people who own this breed will have them cut shorter so that it is easier to care for.

A good length to keep this breed can be achieved using a #4 or #5 guide comb. You can go longer or shorter depending on how often you are willing to brush and groom your dog. Go over the whole dog, including the head and face. Finish up with scissors to even up.
