Welsh Springer Spaniel

Shave ears about halfway down using the clipper without a guide comb and set to the shortest setting. Keep your fingers on the edges of the ears so you do not cut the ears.

Shave ears about half way down using the clipper without a comb and set to the shortest setting. Keep your fingers on the edges so you do not cut the edge.

Trim feet very short with scissors.

The Welsh Springer only comes in Red and White coloring, they are not as tall as the English Springer, but their grooming is very similar.

When grooming this breed, you can use a #2 or #1 comb on the body; use the same guide comb on top of the head. Leave all the long, silky furnishings on the back of the front legs, on the sides of the ribs and tummy area and on the rear legs.
