

Welsh Terrier

This terrier has a very wiry coat and like many terriers can be a handfull. Generally, this dog would be hand stripped, but if he is not being shown you can do his grooming with clippers. Use a #2 or #1 guide comb on the body; you want the hair short, but not skinned. If you cut too short you could damage the skin. Do top of head with the same comb as you used on the body. Do not leave a high "skirt" on your dog; he should have some hair under the ribs and tummy area, but not too much.

He should have hair on his legs as well. If the legs are too full, you can either scissor them or use a #3 or #4 guide comb down the legs and then finish with scissors.

They should have a full beard and mustache as well as small eyebrows. Do sides of face and throat area with a clipper set to the longest setting and without a guide comb. Go with the grain, from corner of eye to ear. Do ear with the blade set at the shortest setting. Keep your fingers under edges of the ear as you shave so you do not cut edge of ears.

Trim feet short with scissors.
