Shave just the tips of the ears with clipper without the guide comb on it. Keep your fingers under the edges so you do not cut the ear.

Westies have a wiry coat, but are not difficult dogs to care for. They require brushing, but their coats do not mat as easily as some other breeds. They require grooming roughly every 8 to 10 weeks.

They have a full-round head and their furnishings are left long and natural. You can do the body with a #2 or #3 guide comb going down from behind the ears. Do not cut up into the head, you want to leave that. Follow the lines down to the elbow and blend as you go towards the rear.

| Scissors any uneven hair on the legs.

| Trim feet with scissors.
